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Important—When staff tries to help bring a child in on the drop-off line please cooperate. Parents cannot walk a child to the door at drop-off time.

Please make every effort to have your child to school on time. If you like our drop-off method, make it work by following our safety procedures. Stay in the right lane when you enter from Route 6, please follow the yellow arrows to the “DROP OFF LANE” in the morning. Please have your child ready to be dropped off by having their coat on and bag ready (It’s a MUST!) **Be safe in the parking lot. Make your goodbyes short!** Remember drop-off is from 8:45 to 9:05 in the morning. Don't all come at once and one kiss would be good! **If you need time to dress your child at drop-off please drive straight ahead to the Dynamic building. Prepare your**

child and then bring them to the staff member by the “purple door”.

Pick-up Time-- A reminder to Parents and Teachers--The teachers are not permitted to discuss your child with you at the door. This is not the appropriate place or time to discuss your child, especially in front of him/her. Call me and I can arrange a time. After the Holidays, we will have conferences.

**** OUR BAD WEATHER POLICY---Please take note**

School Closings--Winter is just around the corner. Listen to the local radio station for school closings and delayed openings (WHUD -100.7 FM) *or* the Lakeland Central School District web site. **-We will do what Lakeland School District does, so listen for what Lakeland Schools announce- Tom Thumb will not make our own announcement.** (We have had problems with the radio station updating our announcements in the past.) **If Lakeland School District closes, we are closed. If Lakeland School District has a delayed opening we will only delay 1 hour.** (No matter how long Lakeland delays, Tom Thumb will be delayed for one hour only.)

****The delayed opening also applies to the Before School Care program** (for those registered for this program). This program opens at 7:50 am on delayed opening days.

Clothing -- Now that the weather is changing please remember to **put your child's name in their jackets**, sweaters, hats and gloves and any other item they may bring to school.

Gym Days & The Playground --It is unsafe for children to wear shoes that hinder their movement. Shoes with a little heel are inappropriate for girls. Work boots and cowboy boots do not help our boys be more agile. They also trip very easily when they run. And please remember that little dresses are fine for parties but not on a regular basis. All children need clothing they are comfortable in, also remember that they might get paint on their clothing. Sneakers on gym days!

****Senior Classes Only:**

"NATIVE AMERICAN INDIAN LONGHOUSE"—Senior classes only will take a trip to the Native American Indian Longhouse in Putnam Valley. They will go by school bus, of course. This trip is made in conjunction with our study of Native American Indians and Thanksgiving. Please dress children appropriately for weather conditions-inside is usually cool. The "Longhouse" we visit is a replica; it is actually the Church of the North American Martyrs, which is part of St. Columbanus Parish. It is about a 5 minute bus ride from the school, the entire trip will last only about 1 hour. Senior parents please read the "Longhouse" note for more information. **For Seniors who attend the 5 day program please check your child's individual note for the exact day they will take the trip!**

Junior Bus Trip--In our continued preparation for emergencies we are going to take the Junior classes for a very short bus trip around the corner (through the Tom Thumb parking lot onto Lexington to Rt 6 and back into the Tom Thumb parking lot). We will do this on the day the
