

### Stay & Play Safely Club



# Tom Thumb will continue our Before School Care at 6:50 am for the 2024 -2025 session.

#### **Before School Care:**

The Lakeland School District will send a bus to transport the children to their elementary schools. Please remember to send your "Application for Transportation" to Lakeland Central School District (available from the Transportation Department at Lakeland). The Stay & Play Safely program will follow Lakeland School District on delayed openings.

#### Tuition Fees for Before School Care (opens at 6:50 am) - \$10 per day

Updated Tuition Fees for 2 children in this program- \$18.00 per day - 20% discount for 2<sup>nd</sup> child.

\*\*When there is a **delay** at Lakeland Schools the Stay & Play Safely Club will open at 7:50 am For Lakeland Schools after a **one hour delay**, the tuition will cost **\$7 per hour for each child.** 

#### **After School Care:**

The Tom Thumb campus closes at 5:30 PM sharp for 2024- 2025 school year.

Lakeland School District will bus the children from their elementary schools to Tom Thumb. Please remember to send your "Application for Transportation" to Lakeland Central School District (available from the Transportation Department at Lakeland).

The Stay & Play Safely program will follow Lakeland School District on early dismissals and closures. If Lakeland closes early, children will still be bussed here and pickup must be ASAP!

## **Tuition Fees for After Care (per child)** (closes at 5:30 pm) **Pick up by**:

4:00 pm - \$11 per day, or 4:30 pm - \$14 per day, or 5:00 pm - \$18 per day, or 5:30 pm - \$22 per day

Updated Tuition Fees for 2 children in this program - 20% discount for 2<sup>nd</sup> child in this program. Pick up by

4:00 pm -\$20 per day, or 4:30 pm - \$25 per day, or by 5:00 pm - \$32per day or by 5:30 pm -\$40 per day

\*A "special half day" program will be offered for those who may need it for the scheduled half days at Lakeland School District at an additional cost. \*Additional "Half Day" (11:30 - 2:45) program fee - \$25 per day per child plus the regular tuition fee for that day. Parents must provide lunch for the child. **2<sup>nd</sup> child discount \$20**.

#### \*\*There are no refunds/credits given for absenteeism.\*

- \*It is imperative that a parent notifies us if a child will not be attending on a day that they are scheduled to attend. Should a child not arrive by bus we contact the school district/parent.
- \*\*Stay & Play Safely Club has NO registration fee, but In order to secure your child's enrollment in this program you must complete a registration form and return it with a **deposit of \$75** (which will be applied to June's tuition cost) to Tom Thumb Preschool office.
- \*\*Tom Thumb and Dynamic Gymnastics Families have first preference for enrollment.
- \*\*For students who attend Stay & Play and also take a class at Dynamic Gymnastics, we offer the following: If your child attends a 4pm class at Dynamic Gymnastics, Stay & Play is \$6, if they attend a 5pm class at Dynamic Gymnastics, Stay & Play is \$10, (These are discounted rates for the Stay & Play Program).

#### **Important information**

Stay & Play Club needs a copy of your child's immunization record (including Covid vaccination if applicable) on file. Please send in with your first month's schedule and payment by August 15<sup>th</sup>. There is a limit of children we can accommodate, and this is on a first come, first serve basis.

Stay & Play Club will administer **only** over the counter topical ointments, Benadryl, Epi-Pen & inhalers provided by the parents with a doctor signed written medical request form provided by Tom Thumb. (If this applies to you, please call the office.)

Children who have special health care needs are those who have chronic physical, developmental, behavioral, or emotional conditions expected to last 12 months or more. These children also require health and related services Stay & Play Club may/may not be able to provide.

The director has the right to request a child be removed from the program for the following reasons: a child poses a threat to others or him/herself, failure of the child and/or parent(s) to abide by the rules or are disruptive to the program, failure to provide required documentation, failure of the parent(s) to meet their financial obligation to the program. The director determines when or if the program does not meet the needs of the child.

It is imperative that a parent notifies us if a child will not be attending Stay & Play on a scheduled day. There are no refunds or credits given for absenteeism.

If Lakeland Central School District has an early dismissal due to weather, children will still be bussed to Tom Thumb if scheduled to attend Stay & Play. Your child will need to be picked up ASAP as Stay & Play Club will be CLOSED! Please have alternate emergency childcare in place if necessary. Provide us with emergency contact name and phone number.
