

Stay & Play Club



This Program Requires a Minimum Attendance of 2 Days per Week

Before School Care:

The Lakeland School District will send a bus to transport the children to their elementary schools. Please remember to send your "*Application for Transportation*" to Lakeland Central School District (available from the Transportation Department at Lakeland). The Stay & Play program will follow Lakeland School District on delayed openings.

Tuition Fees for Before School Care (opens at 6:50 am) - \$10 per day

Updated Tuition Fees for 2 children in this program- \$18.00 per day - 20% discount for 2nd child.

When Lakeland Schools is delayed, the Stay & Play Club will open at 7:50 a.m. For Lakeland Schools, after a one-hour delay, tuition will cost **\$7 per hour per child.

After School Care:

The Tom Thumb campus closes at 6:00 PM for the 2024-2025 school year. Lakeland School District will bus the children from their elementary schools to Tom Thumb. Please remember to send your "Application for Transportation" to Lakeland Central School District (available from the Transportation Department at Lakeland).

The Stay & Play program will follow Lakeland School District on early dismissals and closures. If Lakeland closes early, children will still be bussed here and pickup must be ASAP, as the Stay & Play program will also be closing for the day!

Tuition Fees for After Care (per child) (closes at 6:00 pm)

Pick up by 4:00 pm - \$13 per day, or by 4:30 pm - \$16 per day or by 5:00 pm - \$20 per day or by 5:30 pm - \$24 per day or by 6:00 pm - \$30 per day

<u>Updated Tuition Fees for 2 children in this program - 20% discount for 2nd child in this program.</u>

Pick up by 4:00 pm -\$23.40 per day or by 4:30 pm -\$28.80 per day or by 5:00 pm - \$36 per day or by 5:30 pm -\$43.20 per day or by 6:00 pm -\$54 per day

*A special "Additional Half-Day" Program is offered to those students attending scheduled half-days at Lakeland School District.

*The Additional "Half Day" (11:30 - 2:45) program fee is \$30 per day per child plus the regular after-care tuition fee. Pizza lunch will be served. There is **no discount for the second child for this program.**

No refunds/credits for absenteeism.

- **Tom Thumb and Dynamic Gymnastics Families have first preference for enrollment.
- *It is imperative that a parent notify us if a child will not be attending on the scheduled day. If a child does not arrive by bus, we contact the school district/parent.
- **Stay & Play Club has NO registration fee, but to secure your child's enrollment in this program, you must complete a registration form and return it to the Tom Thumb Preschool office with a deposit of \$75 (will be applied to June's tuition cost).
- **For students who attend Stay & Play and take Dynamic Gymnastics classes, we offer discounted rates:
 - 4 pm Dynamic Gymnastics class is \$8 per gymnastics class day
 - 5 pm Dynamic Gymnastics class is \$12 per gymnastics class day



Stay & Play Club

Important information

There is a 2-day-per-week minimum attendance required for the Stay & Play Club.

Stay & Play Club needs a copy of your child's most recent medical & immunization record on file. Please send it in with your first month's schedule and payment by August 15th. We can only accommodate a certain number of children, and this is on a first-come, first-served basis.

Our facility closes at 6:00 p.m. Please pick up your child promptly. If an emergency occurs to prevent your scheduled pickup, please call to let us know you will be late. After 6 p.m., a late pickup fee of \$25 will be charged for every 15-minute interval. For example, if the parent picks up the child at 6:28 p.m., the late pickup fee will be \$50. If late pickups after 6 p.m. occur more than twice, a conference with one of our Directors will be scheduled.

Stay & Play Club will administer **only** over-the-counter topical ointments, Benadryl, Epi-Pens, and inhalers provided by the parents with a doctor-signed written medical request form provided by Tom Thumb. (If this applies to you, please call the office.)

Children who have special health care needs are those with chronic physical, developmental, behavioral, or emotional conditions expected to last 12 months or more. These children also require health and related services that Stay & Play Club may or may not be able to provide. Please discuss this with our director.

The director has the right to request a child be removed from the program for the following reasons:

- Child poses a threat to others or him/himself
- Failure of the child and/or parent(s) to abide by the rules or are disruptive to the program
- Failure to provide required documentation
- Failure of the parent(s) to meet their financial obligation to the program.

Our director determines when or if the program does not meet the child's needs.

It is imperative that a parent notify us if a child will not be attending Stay & Play on a scheduled day. **No refunds or credits are given for absenteeism**.

If Lakeland Central School District has an early dismissal due to inclement weather, children scheduled to attend Stay & Play will still be bussed to Tom Thumb. **Your child will need to be picked up as soon as possible, as Stay & Play Club will be CLOSED for the day!** Please have alternate emergency childcare in place if necessary. On the registration form, provide us with the emergency contact's name and phone number.
