As a reminder tuition payments are due the 1st of every month. Thank you for your cooperation.

Monday January 19th school is closed- Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Day.

Highlights this month include learning about animals that hibernate, polar bears and penguins. Recognition of colors and basic shapes, listening skills and following directions are all developing skills. Children are now becoming more social with each other and language skills are quickly developing for most children.

Large Motor Skill Activities- in the winter months ThumBelina staff sets up a classroom with large motor activities. Some of these activities are foam shapes to climb on and tunnels to crawl through. Children will also use bean bags and balls to practice tossing and throwing. ThumBelina children that are in the red room with Mrs. Licini will have access to the school gym for large motor activities.



Music with Ms. Claudia will continue on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. The children love when Ms. Claudia comes to ThumBelina to sing and dance with them.

Potty Training- if your child is in the training process, please update their teacher so they can work with your child while at school. The process needs to start at home first then teachers can continue at school. Some children are ready at this point and for some it might take longer. It is best to start the process over the weekend or over a holiday break.
